

Governor is running parallel govt in Gujarat

Gujarat Global News Network, Ahmedabad Gujarat Chief Minister Narendra Modi launched a blistering attack on Governor and Congress at the rally organized in Ahmedabad and demanded that Governor should be recalled. He also reiterated his stand that the centre was doing injustice to Gujarat.

The party has resolved to carry on its public campaign against Gujarat Governor Kamla Beniwal for her anti-Gujarat decision. He said that party was pursuing this demand "with a heavy heart and despite deep respect for her, because the interest of Gujarat will remain on top of priorities. Open chargesheet against the governor was also released at the meeting. He said that it was for the first time in its 50 years that Gujarat has chargesheeted its Governor. He said that he was silent over the issue since 2009 for the sake of the sanctity of the office of the Governor while the centre was trying to misuse Rajbhavan since the time of Nawal Kishore Sharma. Modi said that the centre could not prevent Gujarat from making progress by creating hurdles in its way and by showing a discriminatory attitude to its people in terms of allocations under PDS and gas pricing. He said that Gujarat was going to develop as a new model of inclusive growth with people on its side. He said that Congress was rotting fast. "When Manmohan Singh became the PM, he was a good person, we did not say anything against him. But because of he being with the Congress, he has got spoiled by the rot in Congress, then we need to remove that rot. Modi endorsed a suggestion that an inquiry be conducted in the charges of corruption Congress had made against Vaghela when he was CM in 1997.
